# FROM THE PRINCIPAL

## Tutor Learning Initiative

The Tutor Learning Initiative (TLI) enables schools across Victoria to engage qualified teachers as tutors, to work with small groups of students and support their learning. The initiative is consistent with Australian and international evidence, which shows that small group tutoring is one of the most effective educational interventions available to support students to progress in their learning.

This small group tutoring support is being provided and coordinated by Stephanie Kropp And Jed Dexter. Stephanie and Jed will work with students from all levels to understand their progress in Reading and Mathematics to date and set goals for future learning. This program is differentiated to either assist your child in achieving the expected level in Reading and Mathematics or exceeding it. The Tutor program is currently underway with student in all cohort with the exception of Foundation, due to testing currently being conducted. Throughout the year, TLI will look to support students in all year levels.

## CLPS Froggy Coin Positive Behaviour Program

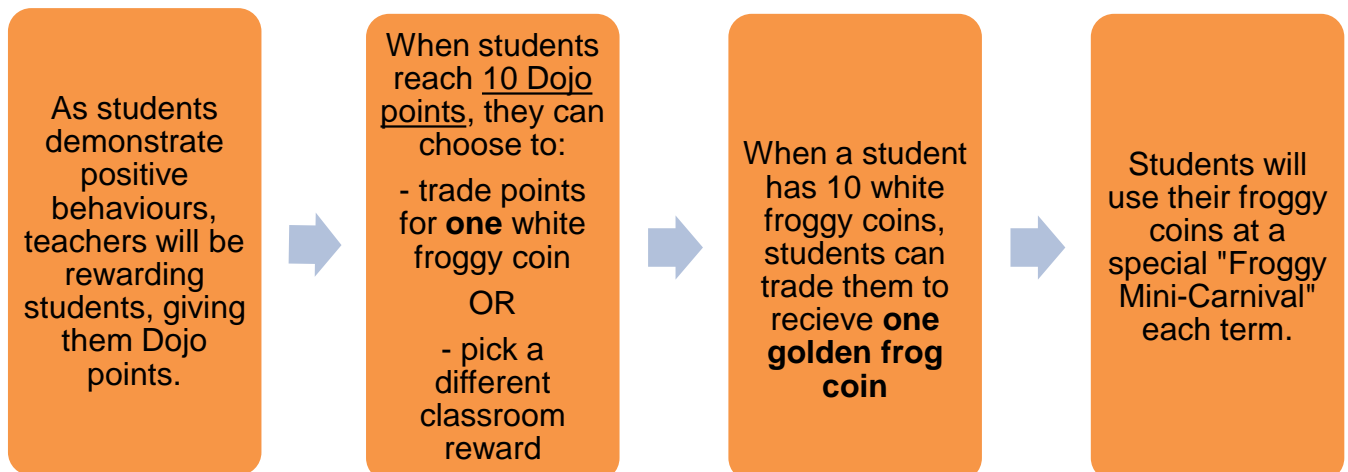
We have launched our new Positive Behaviour Program with 3-6 students this term and will become a school-wide approach for the rest of the school by semester two. This approach focuses on the reinforcement of positive behaviour that is in line with our School Vision and Values.

As students demonstrate positive behaviours, they are rewarded in several ways:

- Dojo points
- Froggy coins (white/gold)
- Special "Froggy Mini-Carnival" to use their coins to spend on items to thank students. Our **first froggy carnival** will be held for students at the end of Term 2.



## How does it work?



### Contacting/Communicating with 3-6 teachers

We will be using Class Dojo as a communication tool to connect 3-6 parents with your child's teacher.

The app allows parents to privately message the teacher to discuss anything related to your child's learning. Parents can message the teacher and the teacher will be able to reply during school working hours (Mon-Fri, 8:30am-4pm). Teachers can also send announcements or reminders to let you know what is happening with your child's learning.

We will be trialling this platform in Term 1 and will implement it in Term 2. More information about accessing the Class Dojo app will be available soon.
